Dr. Sharon McDonnell is the Managing Director of Suicide Bereavement UK and hosts the suicide bereavement conference. She provides a number of free places, for those who do not have sufficient funds, via the Alexander McDonnell Bursary, which was set up in memory of her brother, who died by suicide.

However, demand is high. So we are reaching out to the general public, to ask if anyone would consider adopting a place. These places will be given to people bereaved by suicide and/or professionals who come into contact with the bereaved, who would otherwise be unable to attend.

Those who fund a place will be acknowledged in the conference programme and our website. Many dedicate their act of kindness, in memory of someone they have lost to suicide.
